

### **Position Vacant – Façade Engineer, Structural**

The CWCT (see below) has an opportunity for an engineer with structural engineering training and experience to join our small but committed team in enhancing our provision of guidance and training relating to the structural performance of the building envelope.

The appointment is initially on the basis of a three year contract, which will include CWCT-sponsored attendance on the MSc in Façade Engineering at UWE. The intention is that the successful applicant will join the CWCT at its offices in Bath and attend the MSc from September/October 2020 on a part-time basis over the course of two years.

When not attending the MSc course you will have the opportunity to study and learn about all aspects of façade engineering from our present staff, whom you will also support in the preparation and presentation of various forms of publication and training.
